We have some new and exciting things from the Donor Development area.

If you would like to talk about a few new ideas in how to give to Shriners Hospitals, Kaaba Transportation Fund or Kaaba Shrine, please email or call me.

Recently we created an account with the Community Foundation of the Quad Cities. This opened up a State of Iowa Income Tax credit called "Endow Iowa". I would be happy to go over the details, here is the short version:

• Any gift over \$100 qualifies for a 25% state of Iowa income tax credit.

• In addition starting April 1, if you give a gift to the Kaaba Agency fund at the Community Foundation of the Quad Cities in an amount over \$1,000.55, you still qualify for the State of Iowa tax credit on that amount and they will match your contribution to Kaaba's fund (....up to a maximum of \$10,000 or until funds for this special run out).

• So \$2,000 in our account and it only cost the donor \$750 after the tax credit!!

Remember Kaaba and Shriners Hospitals in your estate plans, it is easy to do any amount, call me if you need ideas.
