

Chicago Board of Governors

Report of Meeting, 22 June 2021

The Board of Governors is made up of Shrine Temples' members from around the Chicago area, consisting of 18 Shrine voting Board members and Associate members with non-voting privileges and hospital administration staff. If there are more than 18 Shrine Temples in the area of a hospital, then a rotation of elected members is alternated among the voting members. In Chicago, our Board has 8 sub-committees that start meeting at 8 AM with some over-lapping others. Then, the combined Board meeting starts at 3 PM and goes until all sub-committees have reported, at least an hour and a half or longer. These Temple Board and Associated members are ALL volunteers.

Some of the things discussed in the June meeting were the 2022 Capital Submission of medical and non-medical items that need to be replaced or newly purchased. There were only 16 items, but with a cost of 1.4 billion dollars. These 16-line items will then be divided into which quarter of 2022 these items will be purchased. The Hospital staff presented this prioritized list to the Board for approval, then that list will be forwarded to Imperial for approval and financing. (So, if you have 1.4 billion dollars not being used or don't need, I am sure Chicago Hospital would appreciate your donation!) The Hospital is also looking for additional area within the building to be used as office space for non-Shriner Hospital doctors to use our facilities and share our expertise. As the #2 Pediatric Hospital in the Chicago area, other hospitals are looking to our Shriner facility for our staff's knowledge and collaboration.

In May 2021, the hospital paid \$9800 for translation services. It is very important that all parents understand what and why their children need our services. In May there were 94 surgeries using a total 20,353 minutes, of which 16 were spinal surgeries and 13 were spinal device implants. We had 1190 on-site out-patient visits and 63 telehealth conferences for May. Expenses are going up, primarily because of the increasing number of spinal surgeries that are being performed and the <u>rising</u> cost of implant devices.

In May, Chicago had 225 new referrals, which is about average when looking back on past years. We also had 37 new referrals withdrawn, because of incorrect phone numbers or e-mail addresses. We have 3 patients to arrive from overseas to have their lives changed and receive some complicated surgeries that cannot be done in their native countries. Additionally, we have 3 over-age individuals returning to receive corrections. One patient could not find a doctor to correct her problem and her doctors referred her back to Chicago because of the expertise that we have.

Now the good news: for those Nobles who attended the Stated meetings, you have heard me speak about a possible name change for Shriners Hospital for Children Chicago. The new name is:



We met with Lauren D'Ambra at 5:30. She proceeded to give each couple a box of 30 CDs to go around and sell to the concert goers as they came in when the doors opened at 6, or after people were in the concert hall. At 7:30 when the concert started, the boxes and money was checked in by Lauren and she gave out wristbands to each of us, third row seats, right in front! Neal Marion Hall 4/7/2021




