

Nobles and Ladies, February was a short, but very busy month for the Shriners Children Chicago facility. During an average month in 2021, Chicago did 10 spine surgeries, but in February, 2022, 13 spine surgeries were completed along with 81 other operations. That is 19,470 minutes of operating room use. The new 400 Ton chiller unit is being used to provide the necessary room temperatures throughout the hospital. The backup chiller unit needs re-

pair and the request for that funding is awaiting the home office approval. There were 149 new patients and 1166 on-site patients as well as 41 telehealth visits to see the Shriner doctors during the 20 days in February.

Our Hospital in Chicago is about 42 years old and some things about the building need to be maintained more than others. The elevators are being serviced by an outside contract and the service has been called several times to adjust the system. Another part that everyone sees are the front doors and they, too, need constant maintenance to keep functioning properly and also are on a service repair contract. The overhead paging system is being replaced with the ability to zone-select a specific paging area of the hospital so not to distract doctors and patients during exams. There is a 3-year contract to purchase the gas and electrical service at a fixed price, helping with the overall utilities cost.


Budgeting is something everyone tries to avoid discussing. The board members and the administrative staff at the hospital spend a lot of the time reviewing this to provide the best possible use of each dollar spent. To see how we are doing check Charity Navigator. Last check Chicago was at 90.1% usage of each dollar given. Chicago donation goal for 2022 is 5 M dollars with a stretch goal of 6.5 M. To date 2.08 M or 21.8% of this year's goal has been received. If you know of someone or you wish to donate to Shriners Children Chicago, contact the Davenport Masonic Center.

If you have checked with your doctor and had to take a later appointment date due to personnel shortage, Shriners Chicago is having some of the same problems. But, at no time will a patient go without the correct amount of care while in the Hospital. We have engaged what is called Agency Nursing. This is where we hire short term 3 to 8 weeks of professional nursing or any other specialty personnel that we need to take care of our Kids in the facility. Any outside help is all ways screened before they are allowed to work within the hospital.

Hospital management is very careful and concerned for the patients' and staff's safety during this Covid situation.

Marlin H. "Bud" Ashcraft passed away peacefully March 16, 2022. Bud had a long "career" in service organizations, becoming a Master Mason in 1953, a 32nd Degree Mason, Knight Commander in 1965 and coronated with his 33rd Degree in 1989. Joining the Mohassan Grotto in 1958, he rose to Monach in 1977 and was a "Minibiker" for nearly 50 years. A Vice President of the Iowa Scottish Rite Masonic Foundation, he was Personal Representative of the Sovereign Grand Inspectors General. A member of the Shrine Director's Staff for 27 years, he was Master of Ceremonies for the induction of new members. He was also a member of the Royal Order of Jesters. Bud regularly drove a bus for children with disabilities to the Shriners Children's hospital in Chicago. Bud was preceeded in death by his wife.

Looking Back in Time Bill Wundram Miracle of the tabs

Aug 4, 1992

We don't need to sit down and look for miracles. They are right here in the Quad-Cities.

Let me tell you about Jack Stamm of Davenport and his pop-top tabs to help crippled children.

Tabs don't weigh much but they add up in a hurry, such as from cross-country truckers who drop them off at Clinton, Iowa, in five-gallon pails. Or from kids in the schools at Prophetstown, Ill., who have collected exactly one-million tabs for Jack. People stop Jack Stamm on the street and give him Baggies full of tabs.

It began as a whim with a bright aluminum lining. The kids in Shrine Hospitals for Crippled Children and Burn Units are better because of Jack Stamm of Davenport and his aluminum tabs. From a handful of tabs that he put into his pocket a couple years ago, it has burgeoned into tons of tabs. To date, he has collected 13,912 pounds of aluminum tab tops.

"In the autumn of 1989, someone gave me some tabs in the hospitality room at a Shrine convention in Kansas City," says Jack, a friendly former potentate of Kaaba Shrine Temple. "They were so little and handy, I thought they'd be a good money-raising project for Shrine Hospitals. The total of Jack's tabs tell the story. In 1990, he collected 2,163 pounds of tab tops. In 1991, tab savers brought him 6,749 pounds. So far in 1992, he has collected 5,000 pounds of tabs.

It takes 908 tabs to make one pound. Tabs have sold as salvage for a max of 48 cents a pound, and are now worth 38 cents a pound. So far, Jack's tabs have raised \$5,572.03 for Shrine Hospitals.

So much for figures. The real story comes from the people who collect the tabs. Not long ago, Marion West, a Shriner who lives in LeClaire, was presiding at a meeting. Jack was puzzled when they asked him to step forward. A curtain parted and in a pyramid, Marion had assembled 50, three-pound coffee cans, each filled to the brim with aluminum tabs. Bartenders at places like Quad-City Downs and the Davenport Moose Club save them for Jack.

At the moment we were visiting, Allen "Bud" Neely of Riverdale, Iowa, phoned Jack: "Can someone come out, I have 100 pounds of tabs in front of my garage." At a Shrine ceremonial in Ottumwa, the nobles gave Jack a pony cart filled with tabs. The Iowa City Shrine Club gives 4-H members from Johnson County a 12-pack of Pepsi for every 100 pounds of tabs.

"The word just gets around about me and the tabs," says Jack. "I had a call to an address in Rock Island; they said they had some tabs. It was in a not-so-hot neighborhood. I was afraid to go to the door of this run-down address, but some burly guy came out and said, 'Oh, yeah, yeah, yeah, You are the tab man.' He did a little jive step and came out with a shopping bag of tabs so heavy I could hardly lift it."

It is like that all the time with the tab man. Kids at Prophetstown, Ill., saved tabs for Jack and used them for a counting project to reach a million; at Monroe School, Davenport, an aquarium was filled with tabs for arithmetic counting; the Clinton Shrine Club has truckers from all over the country collecting tabs; they come in five-gallon pails - the last batch was 36 pails. Stamm has received tabs from nearly every state in the union. Some come by UPS; some bags have quarters and dimes in them.

Whenever Jack has a big load of aluminum tabs, they are hauled on skids (usually from Davenport Masonic Temple) to Alter Co. for salvage retrieval and ultimate recycling. At Alter, the check is made out directly to Shrine Hospitals for Crippled Children.

Stamm, retired as a supervisor of small arms maintenance at Rock Island Arsenal, says his tab collecting has become a full-time retiree job.

"I went to Hi-12 Club meeting the other noon, and three members had little plastic sacks of tab-tops for me. I'm just plain amazed at the way this thing has taken off," he says.
