

We had former shrine coaches visit and talk to us at our practices. Shriners Children's Chicago Board of Governors Meeting

I would like to take a minute to thank everyone for their support of our Board members to Shriners Children's Chicago. As we have in the past and will do in the future, your Board members have attended the Board meetings both in person and by internet. The September meeting was conducted with the Board members attending in person and the Associate members participating by internet. Hopefully, some day we will be able to all get together again in person. Also, I would like to thank everyone who made my re-election for another 3-year term possible to Shriners Children's Chicago. I will strive to do my very best for the Hospital and Kaaba Shriners.

Mr. Graig McGhee, who comes to Chicago from Erie, has the new dual role of being Hospital Administrator and the Midwest Market Administrator. His territory of responsibility will be reaching from Chicago to St. Louis and the Twin Cities. He informed the Chicago Board that "Chicago will take care of more kids, in more places, at a lower overall cost by focusing on" these five areas: Highest Quality, Regulatory Compliance, Care for Children in Need, Shriners Brand and Experience, and Economic Stewardship.

August 2022 was a very busy month for Chicago. Our surgeons performed 118 surgeries with 15 spine surgeries with implants, and 78 outpatient surgeries. With a total of 25,491 minutes of surgeries, by my calculation, that just short of 425 hours or 53 days of surgeries, which is the most surgeries done this year. Way to go, Doctors and Nurses! The Chicago facility had 1491 in-Hospital visits which included 180 new patients, while only 49 patients totally completed their Shriners Hospital care. Chicago also had 50 Telehealth visits. This is something that some patients could be making better use of and we need to tell our patients about. If you don't understand what Telehealth is, please feel free to contact me and I will try to explain how it works. During the budget discussion, Chicago is expecting at least a 3% to 10% increase for all services across the board. This will mean that more overall monies will be required to perform requested services. The 2023 budget, as of now, will be 50+ million dollars. More information on the budget will be forthcoming as numbers are finalized. Chicago is undertaking a study to set up an infusion suite. Over the past several months Chicago has been doing more infusions, using more assets and exhausting nursing staff. As more details become available on the infusion suite, I will pass them on.

One thing that is always constant is the need to repair/replace in building maintenance. The number 6 boiler will have all it's 132 boiler rods replaced at a cost of \$23,887. Additionally, the water chiller unit will be replaced just as soon as temperatures drop low enough to permit work to begin. Both upper and lower coils will be replaced. This unit is 21 years old and will cost \$49,481 and provides "chill water" that is cooled to a specific degree requirement for different uses in most of the Hospital. On October 4, 2022 Morton Arboretum, along with volunteers, will plant 15 trees on hospital property, and then next year they are planning to come back and plant another 15 trees. This project was approved by Imperial.


